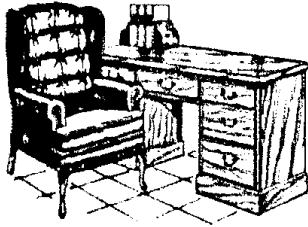


Valentine dinner today for the "seasoned warriors" of the church following morning services in the fellowship room.

From the Preacher's Desk... *Fifty Ways to Love Your Lover*



My friend, Dennis tells this story about Don. Don is a basketball "nut." He's the kind of sports buff who can talk nonstop about his favorite basketball teams with anybody who'll listen. One evening, Don's wife took a seat next to him on the couch. She placed her arms around his neck and asked him point-blank: "Do you love me more than basketball?"

Puzzled, Don considered her question for a long minute before answering. He finally said, "College or NBA?" While most of us men would never make a blunder of that magnitude, we often miss the opportunity to affirm our wives. Marriage is not a spectator sport.

We all would do well to watch Solomon in action. Solomon, by contrast, referred to his wife as "my beloved" forty times in the Song of Solomon. That choice phrase is packed with affirmation. It's a romantic expression, a call to rich friendship. Each time Solomon said, "My beloved," his words clothed her with dignity and value.

Sometimes we men just get out of practice when it comes to making sure our wives feel loved and appreciated. How can you give blessings of love, value and affirmation to your wife?

1. Start the morning with affection - a kiss and hug. Remember, a kiss first thing in the morning isn't necessarily the *best* kiss of the day, it's just the *first* kiss. But what better way to start!
2. Leave a sticky note on the bathroom mirror that says, "Honey, I'm crazy about you!"
3. When you are together with friends, find a way to brag about her. "My wife is such an amazing cook."
4. Put down the newspaper or shut off the computer and say, "Let's go for a walk. I'd love to hear about your day."
5. Make breakfast for her on Saturday morning.
6. Write her a short love letter letting her know how she blesses your life.
