Congratulations to Jerry and Mary Munsell on the marriage of their daughter Megan. She was married to Mark Blinde on Saturday, December 12th in York.

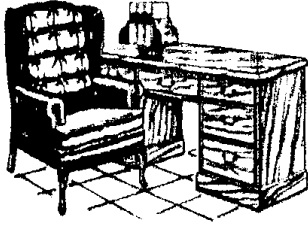
POINSETTIAS
