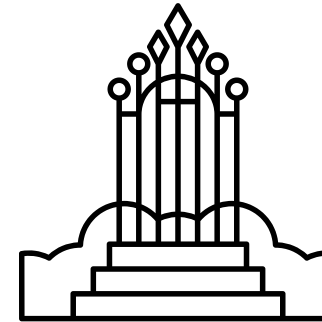

DEVOTIONAL

Abundant Life

Blackaby

Jesus warns us to be on guard for thieves who will try to rob us of what God has for us. Jesus wants us to enjoy abundant life (John 10:10). Since the time of Adam and Eve, people have had to choose whom to believe. Satan convinced Adam and Eve that forfeiting their obedience to God would gain them everything. Instead, their disobedience robbed them of all they had. For the rest of their lives they experienced only a fraction of the blessings God had intended.

Scripture is replete with accounts of those who forfeited their inheritance as children of God in order to gain that which was transitory and empty.

The world seeks to convince us that we will find fulfillment if we adopt its standard of morality for marriage, raising your children, advancing your career, or pursuing pleasure. If we believe this, we will never experience the blessings God intended for us. Sin brings death (Romans 6:23). It is tragic to listen to the voices of the world instead of to the One who created life and who wants us to experience life to its fullest.

Jesus wants us to live our life with security, knowing that we are a beloved child of God. If we are not experiencing love, joy, and peace, we have settled for less than what God intends for us. If we have been making excuses for why we are not experiencing an abundant and joyful life, determine today to settle for nothing less than God's best for our life. Stop following the world's way of finding satisfaction. Instead, listen to the Savior's voice, and we will find true fulfillment.
