We cannot not live in the presence of God. We are totally surrounded by God all the time and everywhere. We have no choice in the matter, except to bring it to consciousness.

God with me, God before me.
God behind me, God within me.
God beneath me, God above me.
God at my right, God at my left.
-a prayer from St. Patrick

We cannot earn God by any practice whatsoever. We cannot prove ourselves worthy of God. Knowing God's presence is simply a matter of awareness, of fully allowing and enjoying the present moment, there are moments when it happens naturally, normally, when we are out of the way. Then life makes sense. Once we can see the Mystery here and trust the Mystery- even in this little piece of clay that we are, in this moment of time that we are- then we can also see it in others and, eventually, in all things.

That would be full enlightenment, "when God is all in all" (1 Corinthians 15:28). There's not question-and-answer here, there is no problem solving here. It is simply pure and unbounded awareness on our part. Any attempt by any religion to say "God is here and not there" is pure heresy. God is in all things precisely in God's ever-newness and God's ever possibility.
