Enticements

Hudson and Campbell

When people commit to going on a diet or starting an exercise regiment, it usually doesn't take long for the discipline to become routine and unpleasant. In short time, they may (consciously or unconsciously) create a reward system: perhaps a cheat meal or a day off. Often, however, the rewards increase until all commitment has diminished.

What is our incentive to strengthen our faith? What do we do when church attendance, prayer commitments, and daily quiet times with God become mundane or even boring? Adam and Eve ate forbidden fruit in an attempt to "be like God" (Genesis 3:5). The Israelites built a golden calf to enhance their spiritual enthusiasm (Exodus 32). We probably all know the results of those enticements.

Let's not make the same mistake. The almighty Lord of the universe has forgiven us and invites us to stand boldly before His throne to receive whatever help we need. What other possible motivation could we need?

All of us will go through periods when spiritual discipline seems routine and unproductive. But the answer isn't to turn elsewhere; it's to draw closer to God.

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
