### **DEVOTIONAL**

### Fix your eyes on God

It is easy to see why Moses became frustrated with the Hebrew people. They were so hard-hearted and weak in their faith that Moses lost his patience and became angry with them. Yet every time Moses shifted his focus away from God, it cost him. When he sought to help his people by taking matters into his own hands, he spent the next forty years herding sheep in the wilderness (Exod. 2:11-15). This time his impetuous behavior cost him the opportunity to enter the Promised Land (Num. 20:12). In his frustration at the people's irreverence, Moses committed the very same sin, blatantly disobeying God's instructions. How did this happen? Moses allowed his attention to shift to the behavior of others rather than focusing on the activity of God.

This could happen to us as well. God has put people around us who need our ministry to them. We will never be able to properly help them, however, unless our primary focus is on God. If we concentrate on people, their weakness, their disobedience, their lack of faith, and their stubbornness will quickly frustrate us. We may, like Moses, commit the very sins we are condemning. If, however our eyes are fixed on Holy God, we become more like Him--gracious, forgiving, long-suffering, and righteous. When a friend's behavior disappoints us, go immediately to the Lord. Seek to discern what God is wanting to do in our friend's life rather than concentrating on our friend's sin. Then we will have the strength, wisdom and patience we need to help our friend in the way God desires.

Moses and Aaron summoned the assembly in front of the rock, and Moses said to them, "Listen, you rebels! Must we bring water out of this rock for you?"
