DEVOTIONAL

The Pure in Heart See God

Jesus said: "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God" (Mt. 5:8). What is the meaning of the expression "see God"? It cannot be a reference to visibly perceiving Jehovah, for no one can see him now (John 1:18; 1 Tim. 6:16) and all, both pure and impure, will see him in the Judgment (Rom. 14:10f).

The term "see" is often used in the Scriptures in the sense of experiencing or entering participation or fellowship with something or someone. Consider, for example, John 3:3. Christ informed Nicodemus that unless one submits to the new birth, he cannot "see" the kingdom of God. Yet, immediately following, the Lord indicated that the new-birth process allows one to "enter into" the kingdom (v.5). Circle "see" and "enter" and connect them, for they are equivalent in this context.

Further, note John 3:36, where it is said that he who believes on Christ "hath" (i.e., experiences) eternal life; but he who obeys not (ASV) shall not "see" life. Again, the term "see" is shown to have a special meaning.

So it is in Matthew 5:8. The pure in heart will *enter a relationship* with God, *possess an intimacy* with him that the world does not have. Thus, in the margin of your text beside Matthew 5:8 write: see John 3:3-5,36. These helpful parallels will remind you of the proper meaning of "see" in Matthew 5:8.
