Making A Difference

Would we dare to believe that God, who called us to Himself and equipped us with His Spirit, could work mightily through us? Have we made the connection between the time and place in which we live and God's call upon us? World events never catch God by surprise. He placed us precisely where we are for a purpose.

Daniel did not let the temptations of his day interfere with his relationship to the Lord. He knew that to make his life useful to God he must be obedient in all things. Regardless of what the most powerful king in the world commanded, Daniel refused to compromise what he knew God required of him.

History is replete with examples of Christian men and women who believed that God would work through them to make a significant difference for His Kingdom. God placed Ester strategically in the king's court at a crucial time when she could save the lives of God's people (Ester 4:14). God placed Joseph strategically to become the most powerful adviser to the pharaoh in Egypt and to save Jacob and his family from a devastating drought (Gen. 41:39-40)
