DEVOTIONAL

FUTURE SHOCK ABSORBERS

Why do so many people fear the future? Each generation seems to look down the road a few years and predict the world will get worse rather than better. Alvin Toffler's Future shock was a peek into an uncertain future that unsettled many of its six million or so readers. Prophecy books seem to be perpetual bestsellersthe more doom and gloom the better.

Usually when God sent a prophet, the messenger had a dire warning about the future--if things didn't change. Yet where God is involved, a forthcoming unpleasant situation is never the end. God sees beyond coming exiles, beyond sieges and destruction, and beyond terrible wars and earthquakes; he assures his people of restoration and renewal. That's why letters in Revelation--with descriptions of horrific beasts, Armageddon, hundred pound hailstones, and martyrs--were sent to seven churches as an encouragement. The unmistakable truth of the book of Revelation is that God is in control, Jesus is coming soon, and God's people can look forward to a new heaven, a new earth, and an as-yet-unrealized intimacy with him. We may not be able to influence the future of the world to any degree, but we have much to say about our future. If we cling to God's inseparable love, we have nothing to fear.

I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels or demons, neither present or future... will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. - **Romans 8;38-39** Christopher Hudson, and Stan Campbell
