DEVOTIONAL

Did Jesus Actually Baptize People?

Clem Thurman-Gospel Minutes Feb 26, 1993

Let us look at the passages. "After these things came Jesus and his disciples into the land of Judea; and there he tarried with them, and baptized" (John 3:22). "When therefore the Lord knew that the Pharisees had heard that Jesus was making and baptizing more disciples than John (although Jesus himself baptized not, but his disciples), he left Judea and departed again into Galilee" (John 4;1-3).

The first passage shows that Jesus was engaged in baptizing people, the second passage shows that the Pharisees knew this and thought He baptized more than John did. But Jesus did not *personally* baptize people, he had the apostles to do the actual baptizing. But when the apostles, *at the direction of Jesus*, baptized people, those people were said to have been baptized by Jesus (John 3:22). Just as God "works in you, to will and to work" (Phil. 2:13), so Christ worked in the apostles to baptize people.
