DEVOTIONAL

Bearing With and Not Against

Solomon said, "The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit (Ecc. 7:8)." Chrysostom called patience "The Queen of the Virtues." There is an old Dutch proverb that says, "A handful of patience is worth more than a bushel of brains." Shakespeare observed, "How poor are they that have not patience! What wound did ever heal but by degrees?" Vaughn Monroe observed, This would be a fine world if men showed as much patience all the time as they do while they are waiting for a fish to bite."

The point of the matter is that we all need patience. Webster's definition of patience is as follows: "bearing pains or trials calmly or without complaint; manifesting forbearance under provocation or strain; not hasty or impetuous; steadfast despite opposition, difficulty, or adversity; able or willing to bear."

When we are faced with dealing with others, something stirs behind our eyes and makes our eyebrows twitch. Most of the time, we would attribute that to frustration, but the root cause is a lack of patience. Patience is a skill that is trained and tempered. Sadly, we don't fully develop the skill, and we cause ourselves more grief than necessary.

I am thankful that I have the Father who is patient with me. God is an eternal being with time to spare; however, I do not have the luxury of eternal time yet. What I have is a finite amount of time to dedicate to the Lord before I meet judgment. 2 Peter 3:9-10 tells me of God's long suffering towards me, but it also tells me that everything will end in fire. I must ask myself if the time that I have left on this earth is worth wasting on clinging to physical things that will not endure the flame. Is my time worth harboring ill will with any of my brothers or sisters in Christ? Is my time worth being outside of the presence of God?

Patience helps us to endure the time that we have left in this world. It also helps us to understand just how infuriating we must be in the eyes of God. Be patient with others, be willing to give up some time for the sake of others, but most importantly, be willing to give your time to God, because it was not your time in the first place.
