DEVOTIONAL

Does Peter let us into heaven?

We may have heard people talk about Peter at the pearly gates of heaven, allowing in only those who deserve to enter. But that is not what the Bible says.

We cannot get into heaven by trying to be good enough-even if we try really really hard. Only Jesus can take away our sin and make us good with His goodness. Jesus said "I am the way and the truth and the life.

No one comes to the Father except through Me." (John 14:6)

So why do some think that Peter is the one who lets us into heaven?

When Jesus was on earth, He said to Peter, "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 16:19). Jesus wasn't talking about actual keys to the gate of heaven, but saying that Peter would be used to tell people about God's plan to save them.

After Jesus had gone back to heaven, Peter preached to a large crowd. Thousands of those who heard Peter's message believed and were saved (Acts 2:38-41).

Just as a servant unlocks the door of a house to let a guest in, so Peter was given the task of opening the door of the kingdom so that people could come to God. The key to the door is the Gospel message-that God sent Jesus to save us from sin.
