DEVOTIONAL

No Spiritual Bypasses Hudson and Campbell

The United States Interstate Highway System is designed to maximize efficiency and ease of travel for drivers going long distances (though you might dispute this assertion at certain times). When traffic around a large city becomes congested and cumbersome, often a bypass is constructed to allow travelers to avoid the city as they travel.

Some of us take this same approach in our spiritual relationships. We want to strengthen our relationship with God, but sometimes other relationships get in the way. When a personal relationship becomes too complicated, demanding, time-consuming, or otherwise dysfunctional, we may try to bypass that person in our eagerness to get closer to God.

Our spiritual relationships, however, can't be like that. Though we may try to disconnect our unpleasant relationships with people from our desired relationship with God, Jesus said those relationships are inextricably connected. God does not want our offering when we know one of our personal relationships is in need of immediate attention. John emphasized the same point, but not as tactfully: "Whoever claims to love God yet hates his brother is a liar" (1 John 4:20)

There is no quick bypass to God. The road to spiritual growth often leads through messy personal relationships that are essential for us to address.

Leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift - Matthew 5:24
