DEVOTIONAL

Better Hopes and Gardens

Believe it or not, at one time there was no such thing as "fast food." Most families planted and tended vegetable gardens. Long weeks would pass between putting a seed in the ground and picking something good to eat. During that time, growers had to contend with late freezes, long periods of too-dry or too-wet conditions, destructive bugs and other critters, and a host of other problems.

By necessity, growers learned lessons of patience and perseverance. Even after the kids could finally see the green tops popping out of the ground, they couldn't be too eager to yank out a ripe radish or carrot. It took a lot of waiting before the fruit or vegetable was mature-ripe and ready.

So it is with spiritual growth. There is no fast track to spiritual maturity; the only route that gets us there begins with challenge. That's why James began his letter with a statement that confounds so many of us: "Consider it pure joy...whenever you face trials of many kinds" (James 1:2). It's a strange joyride, to be sure. Yet our hurts, disappointments, pains, and sufferings teach us perseverance- the primary prerequisite for maturity.

The seed of perseverance, once planted, can take a long time to mature, but its resulting fruit is the joy of an ever-maturing relationship with our loving God. It's well worth the wait!
