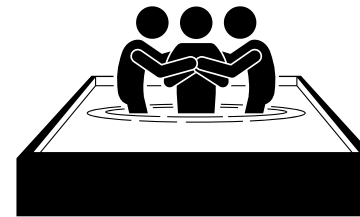

DEVOTIONAL

Christians are responsible for those out of Christ

Some time ago a little girl was lost in the mountains. In one hour after she had wandered away 10,000 men were hunting for her. They never paused one moment till she was found. But all around us are souls going down to eternal ruin, and we are little concerned about it.

In the early church, as soon as a man was converted he ran to tell the good news to his next-door neighbor. Philip was so anxious to teach the Ethiopian that he ran. Acts 8:30

In the early church, each member went everywhere preaching the word. Acts 8:4. Realizing his personal responsibility for the salvation of those who are out of Christ, the Christian will come in contact with the unconverted. If every disciple would bring one person to Christ each year, the whole world would be reached by the gospel in 12 years. Should a Christian bring one man to Christ every year, and inspire the new converts to do the same, the result would be marvelous. In the first year, there would be 2 belonging to the Lord's Church; in the second year 4; the third year, 16... the twentieth year 1,048,000 in rounded numbers.

Matthew 28:19-20- "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you..."
