DEVOTIONAL

God's Love

The great thing about God's love is that it's not determined by the object. God does not love us because we are good, God loves us because *God is good*. It may take our whole lives for that to sink in, along with lots of trials and testing of divine love, because that's not how human love operates.

Human love is largely determined by the attractiveness of the object. When someone is nice, good, not high maintenance, physically attractive, or important, or has a nice personality, we find it much easier to give ourselves to them or to "like" them. That is just the way we humans operate. We must be taught by God and grace to live in an economy of grace. Divine love is a love that operates in a quite unqualified way, without making distinctions and seemingly without such a thing as personal preference. Anyone who receives divine love feels like God's favorite in that moment! We don't even have the capacity to imagine such a notion until we have received it. Divine love is received by surrender instead of any performance principle whatsoever.
