Devotional

In Philippians 4:6-7, Paul sums up an entire theology of prayer practice in very concise form: "Pray with gratitude, and the peace of Christ, which is bigger than knowledge or understanding, will guard both your mind and your heart in Christ Jesus." Only a preexistent attitude of gratitude, a deliberate choice of love over fear, a desire to be positive instead of negative, will allow us to live in the spacious place Paul describes as "the peace of Christ."

In the end, it is not our own doing, or grace would not be grace. It is God's gift, not a reward for work well done. It is nothing for us to be boastful about. We are God's work of art, created in Christ Jesus. All we can do is be what God's Spirit makes us to be, and be thankful to God for the riches God has bestowed on us. Humility, gratitude, and loving service to others are probably the most appropriate responses we can make.
