### Acts 2:37-47

37. Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men and brethren, what shall we do?" 38. Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39. For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." 40. And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." 41. Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. 42. And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. 43. Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. 44. Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, 45. and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need.

# **DEVOTIONAL**

#### **His Resurrection Guarantees Ours**

Paul assures me that nothing separates me from the love of God (Romans 8:38-39). He tells me that Jesus' resurrection by the power of God guarantees mine (1 Cor. 15). The Resurrection of my Lord is a fact as well as a belief. It is the act that created the church. In most early preaching, the church reasoned from the beginning point of the resurrection of Jesus as they explained Christianity.

Because He is the resurrected Lord, Christ rules the creation and works in His Body, the church (Eph. 1:22-23. The spirit that raised Jesus lives in the church (Rom. 8:11). Our baptism re-enacts not only Jesus' death, but His resurrection (Rom. 6). By His power God is going to raise our bodies from the dead just like He raised Jesus (1 Cor. 6:14). Man's courage in the face of death is based upon the "objective power" of the resurrected Christ-in His statement that He is "the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25). The "new creation" can only take place because of our Lord's resurrection. The resurrection says "There is a new day."

Some feel that Paul's keen sense of mission (seen in Acts 17:18,31-32; 23:16) comes from thinking about the resurrection of Christ. The whole Christian hope is securely anchored in the triumph of Christ's resurrection.

Paul wants "to know him and the power of his resurrection" (Phil. 3:10-11).

According to Paul in Philippians 3:20-21, the resurrected Lord will change us to be like Him.

It is so revealing to read that the apostles were in utter despair (disillusionment) after the crucifixion. They did not know their identity, or where their life's direction was going. They went back to fishing. But...they were transformed by the resurrection.

One writer says "The resurrection is why we worship gratefully and live rightly." The resurrection was the event on which all subsequent Christian experience and thinking was based. Through our weekly participation in the Lord's supper, we proclaim the death and resurrection "till he comes". Finally, the resurrection of our Lord tells us that the future can be trusted to God.
