DEVOTIONAL

Volume control

Sometimes God speaks in such a way that no one can miss his message. When Elijah stood against 450 priests of Baal on Mount Carmel, he prayed for a clear sign so the observers would recognize the God of Israel. God responded with a heavenly firestorm that devoured Elijah's sacrifice, altar and all (1 Kings 18:36-39). Not one of the startled Israelites ignored God's message.

Yet Elijah's boldness incited the wrath of Queen Jezebel, who swore he would be dead within a day. Elijah ran for his life and hid in the wilderness, waiting to hear from God. There he witnessed a "great and powerful wind" that tore mountains apart, followed by an earthquake and then a fire. Yet God did not speak from any of those fearsome natural phenomena. Instead, he reassured and encouraged his prophet through "a gentle whisper (1 Kings 19:1-18)

God spoke to Moses from a burning bush (Exodus 3) and to Job out of a storm (Job 38:1). But if we listen for him only in dramatic presentations, we will miss much, if not most, of what he has to say. Often we are hindered by the noise and static on our end. If we regularly find a quiet time and place to listen, however, the softspoken truth of God usually comes through loud and clear.

For God may speak in one way, or in another, Yet man does not perceive it. Job 33:14 -Chistopher Hudson & Stan Cambell

When the two ears are put side by side it forms the shape of the heart. Interestingly, the word 'ear' sits right in the middle of the word "heart" (h-ear-t). The ear is the way to the heart so if we want someone's heart, learn to listen to them. If we want God's heart, learn to listen to Him.
