All we can bring is today's latest product, whatever it is, for a new dose of love. It will always be immature on some level. It will always be inadequate, but that is not the point. It is not the perfection of the gift, but the willingness to lovingly offer the gift, that pleases all parents and, surely, then, the Super Parent that some of us call God.

God does not lead the soul by shaming it, just as a good parent would not shame his or her child. It doesn't work anyway. We all have done it at times and, if we were raised in a punitive way ourselves, we still tend to think that is the way to motivate people--by shaming them or making them feel guilty. Some have done it enough and have received it enough to know that it eventually backfires. It never works. We close down and stop trusting after that, and we use all kinds of defense mechanisms to avoid further vulnerability. God's way actually works--to love us at even-deeper levels than we can know or love ourselves. It is really quite wonderful, and one wonders why anyone would want to miss out on this.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
