Motherhood matters. But when we've gone without sleep, when there's a sink full of dishes and some gross yellow stain on our shirt, when our coffee is cold and it's been soo long since we've showered, when all we want is some uninterrupted time in a nice hot bath, it's easy to question the job's value.
