DEVOTIONAL

A Cup of Cold Water

We read in Matthew 10:42, "And whoever in the name of a disciple gives to one of these little ones even a cup of cold water to drink, truly I say to you, he shall not lose his reward." Do we understand what is really involved in the "cup of cold water" found in Matthew 10:42?

There is more to it than appears on the surface.

In eastern lands, water is drawn up from a well in the courtyard or fetched from a distance. The housewife would bring in a supply of water in the morning and let it stand ready for use. As the day goes on, the water gets warmer or room temperature. It would be easy for the housewife to give a cup of this water to a thirsty friend or stranger. But, a "cup of cold water" implies the kindly thought that would lead the housewife to take the trouble to draw it or fetch it straight from the well...perhaps in the heat of the day. Too often, we give a likeness to "tepid" water in our efforts to save ourselves from extra work. I believe it is in the "cup of cold water" effort where one will not lose their reward.

My father practiced this principle when he taught me as a son, "Do what is expected of you...and then some." This was always required when it was my job to mow the lawn. I was not allowed to just mow down the property line between our house and our neighbor's house. I had to mow from the edge of one neighbors' house to the driveway of the other neighbor's house. The purpose for this was to be neighborly and make our neighbor's side yards look better when we mowed our yard.

The principle in Matthew 10:42 would seem to involve going out of our way in making sacrifices to help the poor and those in need. Such extra effort will have a sure reward. Practice the "do what is expected of you... and then some" principle as found in Matthew 10:42! In a similar way, be willing throughout our lives to always practice the second "mile" principle as found in Matthew 5:41.
