DEVOTIONAL

Remember Jesus Christ on Memorial Day

As we think about those who died protecting our freedoms in America, we are reminded of the King who came to free us from servitude to sin and its consequences. Christ did battle with Satan and the children of darkness, ultimately paying the price of death on a cruel cross. Jesus voluntarily laid down His life to pay the wages of our sin (Romans 6:23), so we could be saved from wrath (Romans 5:9) and have eternal life.

Unlike our fallen American soldiers, Jesus rose from His grave, demonstrating His power over sin and death. He now sits on the right hand of the Father of heaven, making intercession for us.
