DEVOTIONAL

A Proper Heart Producing Fruit for God

God desires His people to bear fruit, but that fruit begins with the heart. In the Parable of the Sower, Jesus taught that only the seed planted in “good ground” — an honest and good heart — will bear fruit (Luke 8:15). A proper heart is necessary for spiritual growth.

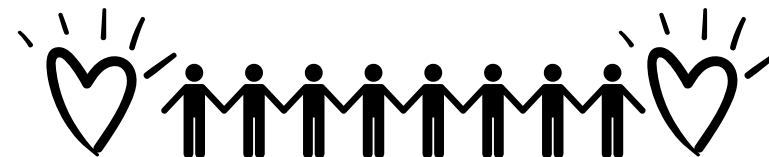
Scripture shows that God looks beyond appearances to the heart. “Man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart” (1 Samuel 16:7). David, though imperfect, was called “a man after God’s own heart” (Acts 13:22) because of his sincere desire to do God’s will.

Jesus said, “A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit” (Matthew 7:18). In other words, fruit comes from the root. If the heart is right, the life will reflect it. Jesus also said, “He who abides in Me... bears much fruit” (John 15:5). Abiding means keeping His word and walking in obedience (John 15:10).

The fruit God seeks includes love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control — the “fruit of the Spirit” (Galatians 5:22-23). These aren’t from external religion but internal transformation. Paul wrote, “With the heart one believes unto righteousness” (Romans 10:10), and James reminded us that faith without works is dead (James 2:17).

A proper heart hears God’s word, accepts it, and acts on it. It produces lasting fruit “with patience” (Luke 8:15). That’s the heart God blesses and uses.

Let us each pray as David did: “Create in me a clean heart, O God” (Psalm 51:10). With a renewed heart, we can truly bear fruit that honors and glorifies Him.
