Devotional

Frequently during Jesus' ministry, people asked Him for mercy - not because He was about to smite them and they wanted Him to hold back, but because they believed He had the power to relieve suffering. And Jesus showed mercy by giving them sight and casting out their demons.

It's easy to focus in this story on what the disciples of Jesus were unable to do and how lesus explained their failure. But another truth revealed by this story is very simple: Jesus has mercy on those who suffer. When the father makes his case before Jesus, he asks for mercy for his son because he "is suffering greatly" (v.15). And Jesus delivered mercy by healing the boy.

One way Christians can imitate Christ is by showing mercy to the suffering. We can use whatever God has given us to ease the suffering of others. It might be our money, or our time, or our skills, or even our position within the culture or the community. Perhaps one of the simplest ways we can be like Jesus is to look for suffering and meet it with mercy.
