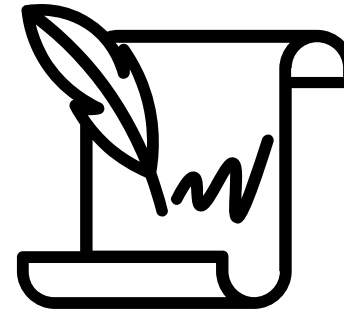

More Logs on the Fire

We need the family of God because we need our neighbors. Have you ever tried to build a fire with a single log? Once the kindling burns out, the fire slowly dies, leaving behind a few smoldering embers and some smoke. However, just add a few extra logs and some fresh air, then watch the flames erupt.

The church works on the same principle. Week after week, people stumble into church depressed and defeated. Then they sing, the Word is preached, and the Lord is praised. Slowly the outlook brightens.

Why? More logs on the fire combined with fresh air of the Spirit! In the same way, the church needs your spark in order to keep the fire burning.

There are so many benefits associated with being a part of a properly functioning biblically centered church family-and rightfully so. At the same time, however, preventing that well of support from running dry requires the invested time and resources of each and every member of the family. No home -or church- can function otherwise.

As members of the body of Christ, we are like pieces of a jigsaw puzzle. Each piece has protrusions and indentations. The protrusions represent our strengths (gifts, talents, abilities), and the indentations represent our weaknesses (faults, limitations, shortcomings, undeveloped areas). The beautiful thing is that, when assembled, the pieces complement one another, blend inconspicuously, and produce a beautiful picture.
